Scriptures: 1 Corinthians 3:10-14 (Katie)

1 Corinthians 3:10 According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building on it. Each builder must choose with care how to build on it.

11 For no one can lay any foundation other than the one that has been laid; that foundation is Jesus Christ.

12 Now if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw—

13 the work of each builder will become visible, for the Day will disclose it, because it will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each has done.

14 If what has been built on the foundation survives, the builder will receive a reward.

Today we continue with the ongoing persecution of the Anabaptists, now in the north of Europe. We examine another reformer's struggle to justify his adult understanding with the teachings of his youth, and one country's change from a focal point of Anabaptist martyr-ism to an Anabaptist haven.
